

Jeanne Schmitzer is a historian, attorney, and librarian. She spent most of her career in public libraries, and recently retired from the Tennessee State Library's Regional Library System which provides support, training, consultation, and technical services to staff and library boards in rural counties across the state. Currently she is an adjunct professor of history at Tennessee Tech University. In 2001, with Kathi Appelt, she co-authored *Down Cut Shin Creek*.

Jason Vance is a faculty librarian, professor, and interim department chair at Middle Tennessee State University's James E. Walker Library. He has done research on scrapbooks assembled decades ago by the Kentucky Pack Horse Librarians. The scrapbooks include local recipes such as baked possum and groundhog, hand-drawn quilt patterns and clippings from donated magazines. The scrapbooks became part of the pack horse libraries' circulating collections of the project that ran from 1936–1943.
